







Strategic Trade Act (STA)

What is STA?

A member of DNoX Group

- To provide control over the export, transshipment, transit and brokering of strategic items
- To provide the international trading community with the assurance that Malaysia is a secured and desirable trading partner
- To deny terrorists' access to our advanced export logistics and capabilities
- Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) is the lead agency for STA



EXPORT, TRANSHIPMENT AND TRANSIT OF STRATEGIC ITEMS AND UNLISTED ITEMS



No person shall export, transship or bring in transit strategic items or unlisted items:

- unless a permit is issued under the Act;
- to a specified restricted end-user (a special permit is required); or
- no permit will be issued to a specified prohibited end-user.




TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING UNLISTED ITEMS AND RESTRICTED ACTIVITIES

- If a person is <u>informed by the relevant Authority</u>/<u>knows</u>/<u>has reason</u> <u>to believe</u> that any unlisted item will or may be used for a restricted activity, he <u>shall notify the relevant Authority</u> of <u>his intention to export</u> the unlisted item at least 30 days before the export.
- Upon such notification, the <u>relevant Authority shall decide</u> whether or not to allow that export.
- The relevant Authority **may decide to allow** that export to proceed by issuing the **export permit**.

TYPES OF PERMITS





EXCEPTIONS FOR PERMITS



- Transit and Transshipment
 - arrive in a free commercial zone (FCZ) or brought immediately into FCZ
 - remain in the FCZ
 - no more than 30 days





HOWEVER...

- No exception for Transit North Korea and Iran
- No exception for Transit for Military Items to:
 - Congo

- Ivory Coast

- Lebanon
- Afghanistan
- Liberia
- Somalia
- Libya

- Sudan
- Iraq
- Rwanda
- Eritrea



NO EXCEPTION FOR PERMIT

- No exception for Transshipment Permit for <u>Schedule Three</u> items of the STA Regulations 2010. Items, e.g.:
 - Military items rifles, revolvers, pistols, ammunitions, bombs, torpedoes, rockets, missiles, war vessels, war aircrafts
 - Nuclear reactors, gas centrifuge plant
 - Uranium, maraging steel, tungsten, molybdenum
 - Toxic chemicals, human pathogens
 - Information security cryptography, test equipment

ePermit (STA) Matters

What is ePermit (STA)?





Web-based system for the application and approval of pre-registration and permits under STA

Approved permits will be transmitted to Sistem Maklumat Kastam (SMK) for **cross-reference purposes against Customs declaration**

Designed to meet the **specific requirements of STA** for the purposes of products monitoring and standard

Creates a **virtual community** for **key players** in the trade supply chain - **paper-less** environment

Main Components in ePermit (STA)

DAGANGNET


Pre-registration for STA

- Registration of Company Details, End Users (Importers) and Authorized
 Applicants, which will be approved by MITI
- Registration of STA Products, which will be approved by the respective agencies i.e., MITI, AELB, MCMC, Pharmaceutical Department
- User IDs will be created based on approved Authorized Applicants
- Authorized Applicant will receive a token for digital signature purposes on permits

Permits for STA


- Application of permits for export, transshipment, transit and brokering for strategic items
- Approvals will be made by respective agencies, based on products
- Digital signature by applicant and approver will be used in this process
